## STUDENT DRESS CODE (Grades 7-12)

Students in grades 7-12 are not required to wear uniforms and shall dress in accordance with Board Policy and the Student Handbook. The Student Handbook includes standards for student dress that provide notice of what types of clothing are appropriate. The dress code standards are enforced by building administrators. Final interpretations of appropriate dress and grooming will reside with the building principal. The principal may exclude a student who in his/her discretion is not dressed in compliance with the standards.

A student may request an exception to the standards based on personal circumstances. Requests must be made in writing to the building principal and signed by a parent if the student is under the age of eighteen. Permission must be granted by the building principal before a student deviates from the student dress code standards.
