SECTION I

The Board of Education declares that purchases and expenses incurred to recognize and honor students, volunteers, advisory groups, and staff for their contributions in support of the educational mission and goals of the St. Bernard-Elmwood Place City School District serves a proper public purpose.

SECTION II

The Board of Education further authorizes administrators to purchase meals, refreshments, token retirement gifts and meritorious service awards, and/or other amenities, which may include teacher or student recognition as gifts appropriate to the occasion, and to support the staff wellness program.
